Notes from January Congregation Council Meeting

Our first meeting of 2025 was held last Monday, January 13. New members Kathy Burson, Lynne Immell and Becky Rensel were welcomed. Remaining members of our council are Carol Clelland, Maxine Montgomery, Randy Neidig, Bill Rowe and Pastor Marleen Griffith-Stull. Officers for the new year were elected: Carol Clelland, President, Kathy Burson, Vice President, Maxine Montgomery, Secretary, Cheryl Neidig, Treasurer, and Susanne Zeiders, Recording Secretary. Many thanks with gratitude for these faithful leaders.

Now that we have an agreement with Mt. Zion church of Churchtown, a call committee of 3 persons from each church will begin the process of putting together church profiles. Our call committee will be Lloyd Sheaffer, Kathy Burson, Becky Rensel, and Maxine Montgomery as an alternate.

Negotiations have proceeded with the Nepalese Congregation to rent our facilities for their worship, Bible Study, and Youth Meetings. The goal is for them to start in February. They have an average of 60 worshippers and 16 youth. They will use our sanctuary from 1-4 p.m. on Sundays and will have Bible Study Fridays, 6-8 p.m., and youth meetings 10-12 Saturday mornings. Please welcome our new friends.

Finances for 2024 show a shortage between income and expenditures of \$2,543. The wonderful news is that revenue for Synod Benevolence exceeded the budgeted amount of \$5,200 to a total of \$10,762! Refer to the end of year financial status printed below.

Finally, Cheryl and Randy Neidig will represent our congregation at this year's synod convention in June, when a new bishop will be elected.
